He became the catalyst to start a social enterprise based on the values of quality, dignity and inclusiveness.

The café founders are parents and friends who wish to make a difference to the special needs community and others who need a leg up in society.

Their dream is to provide opportunities for jobs, showcase special talents and to raise awareness and contributions by supporters of the cause.

Hence, the Professor Brawn Cafe was borne.

Since it was my first time there, I decided to order several different set meals to sample a little bit of everything.

I started my meal with the Prof's Signature Fish & Chips as it seems to be the specialty dish for the cafe.

True enough, it did not disappoint.

The fish was fried till a golden brown and was crispy on the outside and fluffy on the inside.

The accompanying fries were not too salty and were drained totally of excess oil.

The batter could have been a little lighter but overall it was a very fulfilling meal.

Oh and all set lunches (between 11am to 3pm) come with a complimentary Soup of the Day and a house drink.

Another signature dish was the Savoury BBQ Pork Ribs which were soft and succulent.

The meat was so tender it practically slid off the bones.

The Grilled Chicken with Truffle Sauce was no pushover as well, with the chicken being extremely tender, tasty and well infused with the truffle sauce.

Last but not the least was the Gourmet Sausage with Rosti.

The sausage was extremely chewy and savoury with a generous helping of rosti to go with. It was a match made in heaven, period.

You can pick from their selection of sausages including Cheesy Pork and Spicy Italian.

All in all, the food was pretty good and well presented.
